3. You must have applied to a college, university or vocational school and will be attending in the fall of 2025.
4. You must have participated in a St. Johns Youth Baseball Association program.

Priority will be given to students who are highly involved in the community and in school activities.

Applicants should return the enclosed form to the high school office by May 1, 2025.
