SUPPLIES:

Students will store their individual supplies in their desks. While certainly not required, some parents like to provide supplies for the classroom. Below is a list of suggested items that students will use throughout the year:

- Glue Sticks
- Zip lock baggies (gallon and sandwich sized)
- Headphones (unpackage them, make sure they fit your child and bring them in a ziplock bag with their name labeled on the baggie)
- Pencils: wooden/not mechanical (pre-sharpened ©)
- Crayons (standard box ~ no more than 16 in a box)
- Scissors
- 2 thin dry-erase markers for whiteboard practice
- Pencil box/container to hold ALL of the items above

*We go through a lot of Kleenex, black/thin dry erase markers and Clorox Wipes so please think about donating some to the classroom. You can bring items in at Open House or on the first day of school.

BIRTHDAY TREATS/ INVITATIONS:

Riley Elementary does not allow birthday treats to come to school, per the student handbook. Your child will be celebrated when we sing to them and when they choose a choice activity for the whole class to participate in. We ask that you not send in birthday party invitations to be distributed in school.

SNACK TIME:

In first grade, we do individual snacks as opposed to community snacks. Each afternoon, we will take a few minutes to have a snack so please send something nutritious with your child (goldfish crackers, granola bar, fresh fruit, vegetables, etc.). We are a peanut/nut free classroom due to allergies.

FRIDAY FOLDERS:

You can expect to find important notes from the office and our classroom each week in your child's Friday Folder. Please return the folder to school each Monday.

LUNCH MONEY:

If you choose to order lunch you can pay online through the SJPS website.

I believe we are on the same team, so your support is greatly appreciated. Every two weeks I will communicate important dates, classroom content information, etc. through an email titled "First Grade Updates."
